



## Oklahoma Red Angus Association State Sale

1. An Oklahoma Red Angus Association membership is required.
2. The State Sale will be held in April 7, 2018 at OKC West Sale Facility, El Reno OK
3. Cattle Guidelines
  - a. Cattle will be a Body Condition Score (BCS) 6 or better. Cattle will be free from Blemishes, pink eye, ring worm, warts etc. Cattle will be sound and free from hoof deformities.
  - b. Commercial females must be at least 50% red angus
  - c. Pregnancy test is required within 30 days of sale. All disputes are between buyer and seller. All animals are guaranteed by the seller as outlined in the Red Angus Association of America code of ethical sale practices.
  - d. Sale is open to
    - i. Registered Females (8 years and younger)
    - ii. Commercial females (4 years and younger)
    - iii. Bulls that have been developed through the State bull test.
4. Expenses
  - a. Catalog entry fee of \$100/head will be charged for registered females. This fee will be applied to sale expenses at the time of settlement. In the event of scratch, the fee is non-refundable.
  - b. Catalog entry fee for Commercial \$25/head. This fee will be applied to sale expenses at the time of settlement. In the event of scratch, the fee is non-refundable.
  - c. Commercial cattle will be set at a 4.5% commission
  - d. Bull test entry fee \$50. This will not be used for sale expenses.
  - e. Sale expense for registered will be a minimum of 15%
    - i. Example a \$3000 animal through the sale will net \$2550 to owner.
    - ii. Example a \$1500 animal through the sale will net \$1275 to owner.
  - f. PO Fee will be the commission multiplied by last bid through the sale ring.

5. Catalog
  - a. Consignors are responsible for photos and footnotes for their animals.
  - b. Advertisements will be available in the catalog. One page will be \$500, ½ page will be \$300. Consignors will receive 50% discount for advertisements.
  
6. General Health
  - a. All consignors will provide health papers for their animals for interstate shipment. All consignors must comply with Oklahoma requirements for health papers.
  
7. All registrations must be complete before checks are sent to seller.
  
8. In the event an animal must be scratched, substitutions will be accepted with approval of the sale committee.
  
9. The Oklahoma Red Angus Association strives to maintain quality in State Sale for the reputation of consignors and the breed. The Oklahoma Red Angus Association and Sale committee have the responsibility to prevent any cattle from selling if they do not meet the requirements listed above.
